Having, learnt fruit carving, while on a holiday in Thailand, this Rotarian (of varied interests), meticulously practiced at it, till he became versatile at not only carving watermelons, but papayas and mangoes too.

PP Ooi, then allowed some of the Rotarian spouses, who were present, a “hands on” in fruit carving.

PP Ooi is not only enthusiastic about fruit carving, but also art, music, astronomy and of course wines!! He is a great organizer and an indispensable member of the club, as each and every member of the club is.

In order to do fruit carving, one has to have the right tools; a carving knife and a small, but sharp knife to de-skin the fruit.

You have to cut the base of the fruit flat so that it stands. Then de-skin the fruit. Next you carve the fruit. You can carve a single flower on the fruit, or you can carve several flowers on a single fruit.

Interactor Aaron from SDJ invites members to the schools Interact Club Installation on Saturday, 8 October @ the school hall from 9.00am till 12 noon.....



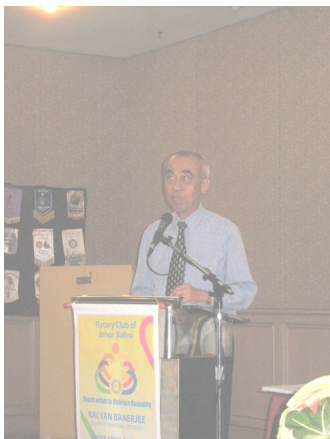
Birthday greetings to PDG Lim Hock Teck on his birthday.....
